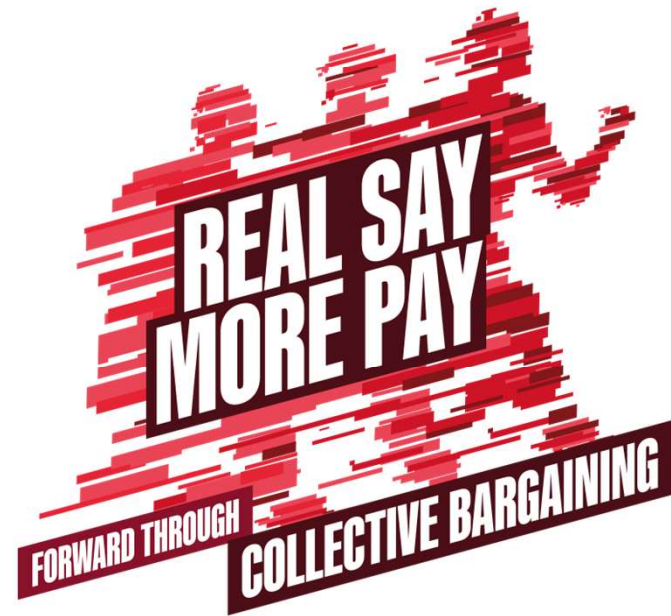

Glove standardization process

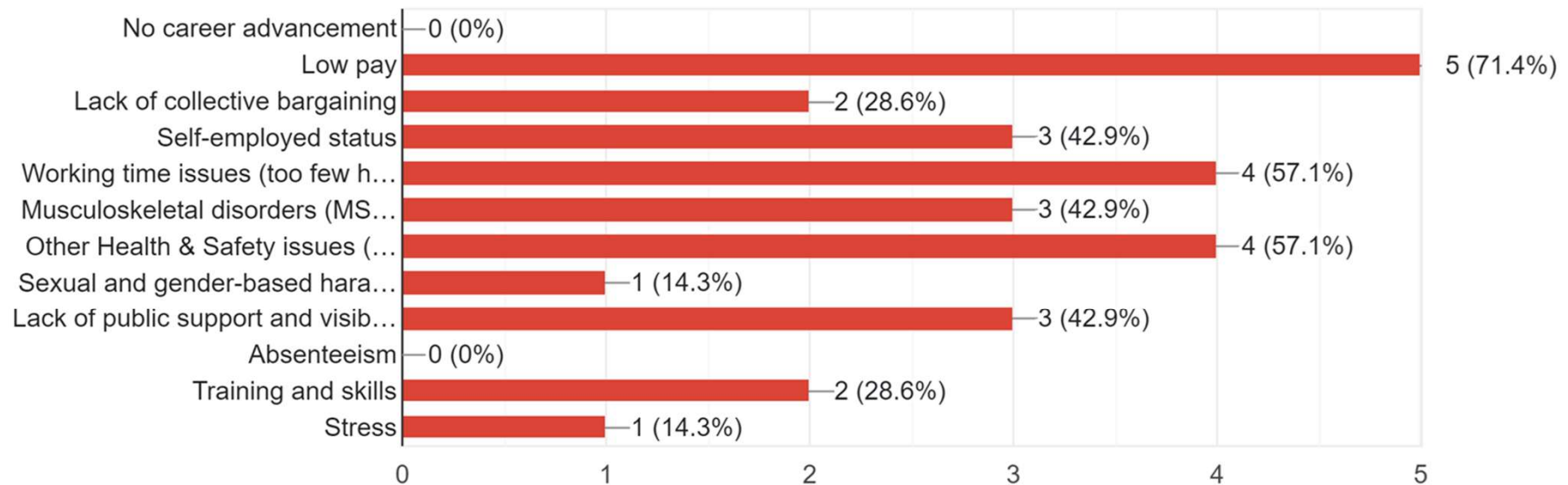
- Editorial finalization of the draft standard in the first half of 2024.
- In June 2024 the HAS consultant submitted a negative opinion of the standard.
- CEN meeting in October 2024
- Possible setback of some months before standard is published by CEN and ISO

- Drafting a new work program based on Social Dialogue meetings and survey responses from members

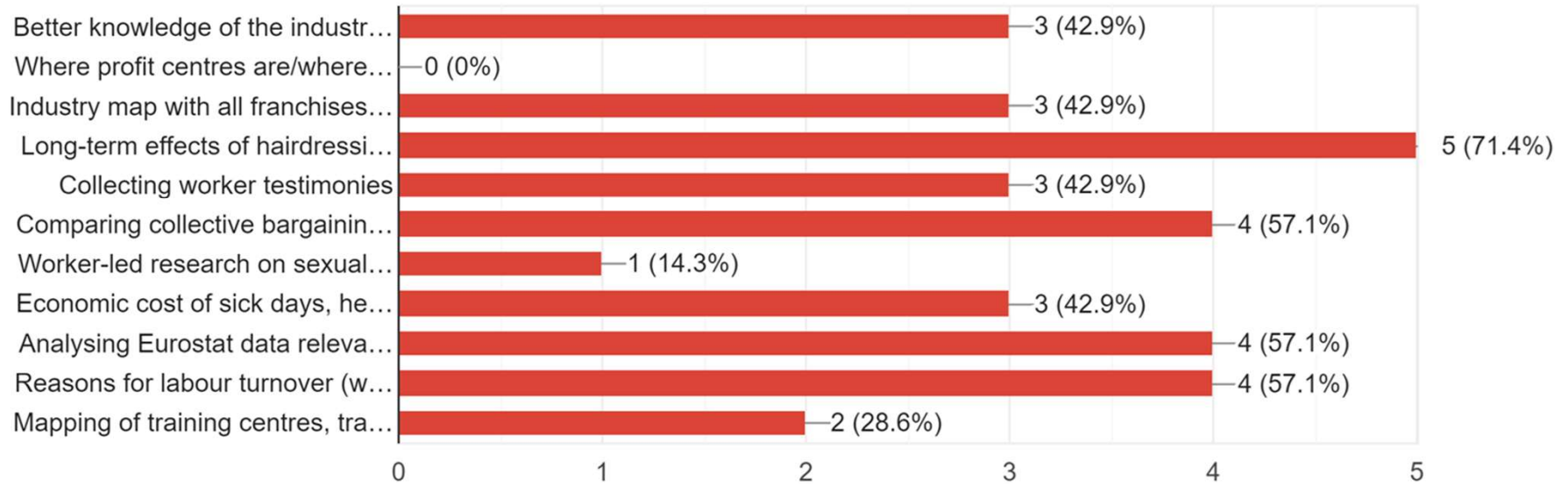
What are the main issues that hairdressers and barbers face in your country? (You can select more than one)

- To produce a CBA report on the hairdressing sector in Europe

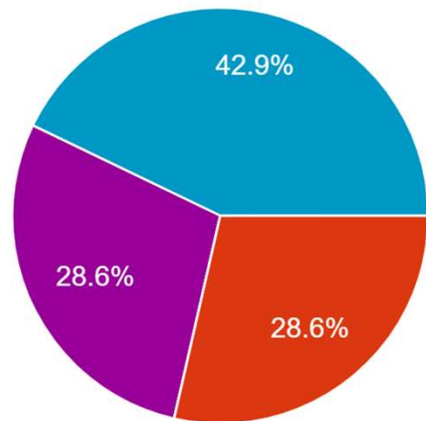
What should a study of the sector focus on?
